#### □ Prepare for the Test

You will receive a study guide by grade level created by Macfarlane Park teachers. Make sure to study in preparation to take the Academic Games test.

#### □ Secure Sponsors

There is a Sponsorship Form in your packet to take to your family and friends so they can sponsor you (parents can ask co-workers, family, neighbors, etc.). Remember, SAFETY FIRST!! Do not go door-to-door without an adult! Please write down all sponsor names on the sponsorship form. They can sponsor you with any amount they would like to donate. Donations should be collected at the time they commit to sponsoring you. You have 3 weeks to obtain all your sponsors!

#### □ **Turn in your Donations:**

- Please *return your Sponsor Form* with donations in the collection envelope by <u>September 20th</u> to be included in the prize drawings.
- If you turn in your donations early....by Friday; September 6<sup>th</sup> you will earn <u>3 early bird raffle tickets</u> to use towards prizes.

## **Academic Games Rules and Prizes**

Students will have multiple ways to participate in this year's event:

- 1. Students will have the ability to earn individual **Gold**, **Silver**, **or Bronze medals** based on their successful completion of the Academic Games Test. Students that score 90% or better will earn a Gold medal. Students that score 80% will earn a Silver medal. Students that score 70% will earn a Bronze medal.
- 2. Each grade will ALSO compete as a "Florida college football team" (Kindergarten = Florida Atlantic University, 1<sup>st</sup> grade = University of Miami, etc.). PTA will maintain a leader board of <u>tracked donation amounts by team</u>. The winning "team" (grade) will have bragging rights as designated Academic Games champions and receive a classroom trophy!!

#### 3. PRIZES

 a. Students that earn a Gold Medal on the Academic Games test will earn 3 raffle tickets. Children that earn a Silver Medal will earn 2 raffle tickets. Students that earn a Bronze medal will earn one raffle ticket. The raffle tickets will be distributed to the children and can be used to "bid" on prizes of their choice. *The more raffle tickets they have the more chances they will have to bid on a prize or multiple prizes.*

#### 4. CLOSING CEREMONIES

The contest ends at our "closing ceremonies" on Friday, September 27<sup>th</sup>. All students will attend the closing ceremony assembly, regardless of test scores or donation amount. It is at the closing ceremonies that Dr. Riveiro will announce the Overall Academic Games Champions and draw the PRIZE winners!

Spanish: Match: Spanish /English ojos, naris, boca

#### Second Grade (15 questions)

Math Problems: Comparing: greater/less than Addition/Subtraction Value of Money

Science: What is gravity?

Social Skills: Proper procedures and behavior in the lunchroom

#### Fifth Grade (20 questions)

Spelling Words: tolerable, succeed, empathy, independence

#### Math Problems:

-Know how to multiply double digits and long division in a real world word problem
-Know Place Values of numbers up to hundred-thousands.

Science: Know the steps of the Scientific Method

Spanish: -What do you say (in Spanish) after someone does a favor for you?

-Know your days of the week: Que dia es hoy?

-How does the quality of being open minded allows students to make exceptional contributions in the community and school? -Know the IB student attitudes: creativity, empathy, tolerance
